

Safety Guide-lines for Go-kart Driver

1. Before any go-karting activity, it is mandatory for participants to wear proper protective equipment (helmets/caps), according to coach's instruction.
2. In order to avoid accidents taking place, kart drivers with shoulder length hair must be tied up, those wearing jackets must be tightly buttoned, and jacket with a rope or a cap will not be allowed. In addition, one cannot wear scarves, bow ties, neckties, long ornaments, etc., cannot wear sandals, slippers, high heels or barefoot and long or short skirts for kart driving.
3. Participants of kart racing activities must be in excellent health condition, and any participants who have suffered from heart problems, high blood pressure, sight problems or breathing sicknesses, pregnant women, flustered persons and those affected by drugs are not allowed to participate in kart racing activities.
4. All drivers must check the brakes system thoroughly to check whether it is in normal condition before driving.
5. Use left foot to control the brake, use right foot to step on accelerator. Kart speed must be reduced before any turns.
6. If there is any collision or kart goes out of control, make sure you clench on the steering wheel without panic, do not let go to avoid being thrown out of the kart.
7. When driving, concentrate on the racetrack, do not look around to avoid accident.
8. Karts on the racetrack must drive in a clockwise direction, not anti-clockwise.
9. Follow the venue route, while on the track, shall not cause collision intentionally, pushing, drifting, sliding off the runway and changing karts privately and other dangerous actions, if any of those conditions occur, raise hand immediately to inform staff for handling the situation.
10. Kart contest holding in private is prohibited on the racetrack.
11. Unless accident occurred, do not stop the kart in the middle of the racetrack.
12. If there is any kart engine failure, while on racetrack, do not leave the kart but raise hand and wait for track staff to come and help out.
13. Should track staff wave checker flag while you are on the racetrack, it indicates that the kart hiring time is over, kindly follow the track staff's instruction and return to the assembly area.
14. If red flag is signaled on the racetrack, it means there are hazardous conditions on the runway, all drivers must return to the assembly area
15. Before you disembark, look around to ensure your personal safety and make sure no other karts are passing by.
16. When returning to the assembly area, should reduce speed and only disembark the kart when it is at a complete stop as directed by the staff.
17. In case of rain or other inclement weather, for safety reasons, the staff have the right to suspend any karting activities according to the slippery conditions of the racetrack.

Rules & regulations for the Kart Hirers

1. All drivers required to meet our minimum height of 1.5meter, holding a valid driving license in order to participate the activity.
2. Coloane Karting Track is divided into two forms of hiring: Private Usage (hourly rate) and Individual Usage (every 15 minutes).
3. For individual usage, each person can only hire the kart for 15 minutes, after this round, tickets can be purchased for the next round, but if other users are waiting in queue, the order should be followed accordingly. Ticket receipt is required for admission usage.
4. The kart rental is 15 minutes per session; maximum 15 karts are permitted on the racetrack. After each session, the kart must stop for 5 minutes for refueling and resting.
5. Participants in kart racing activities must abide by the one person per kart rule.
6. Hirers must be familiar with the relevant kart driving guidelines, and must listen to the staff operational explanation, and sign the declaration accordingly, demonstrate clearly of understanding the rules and operation for the karting activities and the risks involved will then be permitted for driving on the racetrack.
7. As the explanation of driving and operation codes required time, please arrive at the Coloane Karting Track 30 minutes before the appointed time, in order to ensure using the kart on time.
8. The hirer should bear any loss or repair costs if it is his/her fault that caused damage on his/her driving kart, other karts or equipment on the racetrack.
9. Tickets must be used on the date of sale, any overdue will not be honored.
10. For guests who have accompanied with children are strongly recommended to use our public grand stand to view the kart racing activities. Children are prohibited to enter the racetrack area without the supervision of their parents or guardians.
11. Hirers are strictly prohibited from entering the racetrack area without the permission of the staff.
12. Hirers are responsible for their own personal belongings; please look after them with care.
13. In case of any dispute, Sport Development Board reserves the right on taking final decision on any issue.
