5. **Objective:** Promotion of the modality of Dragon Boat, strengthening of foreign relations and development of sports and tourism activities.

Notes:

- a) Macao Dragon Boat and Small Dragon Boat Races (Men's and Women's Open) – open to local teams only.
 - b) Macao International Dragon Boat Races (Invitational) – Men and Women: open to teams being invited only.
7. **Venue and Itinerary:** "Sai Van" Lake with distance of 250m for small dragon boat and 500m for big dragon boat.
 8. **Terms & Conditions:**
 - (1) **Macao Small Dragon Boat Race – Men's and Women's Open;**
 - Macao Dragon Boat Race – Men's and Women's Open**
 - a. Open to the sports associations and collective organisations legally constituted and registered in the Macao Sport Development Board or Macao government;
 - b. Open to Public Services;

- c. Open to teams representing private companies and commercial entities, legal commercial registration document copy should be submitted together with the Team Registration Form;
- d. Open to all individuals, without any nationality discrimination, holders of an identification document issued by the Macao SAR as BIR, or Residence permit or non-residence working permit;
- e. Athletes must obtain a Macao registered doctor's signature on the Individual Registration Form to certify they are healthy for the race;
- f. Athletes must be at least 15 years of age on the day of the race, for those under 18 years old must have their legal guardian's signature on the Individual Registration Form.
- g. Each team's drummer, steersman and paddlers must be of the same gender.
- h. Restrictions in participating additional races are stipulated in term 9.

(2) Macao Civil Servants Small Dragon Boat Race

- a. Eligible for public administration departments and institutions of the Macao SAR Government (12 teams)
- b. Athletes must be employees of the institutions and copies of staff card have to be presented upon registration (except steersman, but have to apply upon registration).
- c. Athletes should meet the requirement of the terms and conditions no. d, e, g and h of the Small Dragon Boat Race.
- d. All paddlers should not have participated in previous competitions. (except the Macao Civil Servants Small Dragon Boat Race)

(3) Macao University Student Invitational Dragon Boat Race – Men and Women

- a. Paddlers, steersmen and drummers of the local teams should submit copy of current year's student card upon registration.
 - b. Paddlers of the invitational teams should meet the requirement of FISU, and no restrictions applied on other members.
 - c. Each team's drummer, steersman and paddlers can only participate in the same gender's category.
 - d. Restrictions in participating additional races are stipulated in term 9.
9. **Restriction:** To avoid delay of events due to athletes' competing in other events, all crew members (including drummers, steersmen and paddlers) cannot join other teams of the same race.

Note: Should the registrations exceed the above established number of teams, a draw procedure will be implemented to define the qualifying teams to this year's races, excluding the teams listed below:

1. Macao Small Dragon Boat Race – Men's Open: the best 12 teams from the Heat round of the same race in 2004 will be qualified directly for the race.
 2. Macao Small Dragon Boat Race – Women's Open: the best 6 teams from the Heat round of the same race in 2004 will be qualified directly for the race.
 3. Macao Dragon Boat Race – Men's Open: the best 24 teams from the Heat round of the same race in 2004 will be qualified directly for the race
 4. Macao Dragon Boat Race – Women's Open: the best 6 teams from the Heat round of the same race in 2004 will be qualified directly for the race
 5. Each entity should only enroll one team in the same category.
11. **Registration:** until 17h30 of 31 March 2005, after which registration will not be accepted.
 12. **Draw:** At 17h30, on 7 April 2005 at the Macao Sport Development Board Auditorium.
 13. **Last date for submission of Team List and Individual Registration Form:**
Teams who fail to submit the above by 17h30 on 2 May 2004 will be disqualified.

 15. **Formalities:** Submit all duly completed Team Registration Form, Team List and Individual Registration Form, accompanied by the following documents of each participating athlete:
 - (1) Macao citizen: A copy of BIR;
 - (2) Foreigners: Copy of Resident permit or non-resident working permit;
 - (3) 2 recent color photos of 1 1/2 inch;
 - (4) Local registered doctor's signature on the Individual Registration Form (for athletes only);
 - (5) Guardian's signature on the Individual Registration Form (for athletes of age under 18).
 16. **Registration fee:** No registration fee is required.
 17. **Training:** The Organising Committee will arrange a training timetable and necessary facilities and equipments at the venue for the teams.

- (1) If teams wish to train during the period not occupied in the timetable, should contact the staff at the venue for arrangement of registration;
- (2) Should teams failed to register for training 15 minutes after schedule will be considered as forfeiting this training session; staff at the venue has the right to release this training session to other teams; however the concerned teams can re-register for training in another session;
- (3) Each team should compose of the minimum athletes in each training session (for big dragon boat – 13 athletes including the steersman; for small dragon boat – 7 athletes including the steersman).

18. **Prize money:** The following prize money will be awarded to the first three teams of each race - Men and Women:

19. **Prizes:**

Prizes by position

1) Macao Civil Servants Small Dragon Boat Race

The first three teams of the Final will be awarded with trophies and silk banners, as well as a medal for each athlete;

If the same team participate in a race with the combination of: the drummer being a chief of the respective department and a minimum of 2 female athletes will be awarded with a souvenir for the “Best Team Combination”.

2) Macao Small Dragon Boat Races – Men’s Open and Women’s Open

The first three teams of the Final will be awarded with trophies and silk banners, as well as a medal for each athlete. For 4th to 6th teams will be awarded with trophies;

3) Macao Dragon Boat Races – Men’s Open and Women’s Open

The first three teams of the Final will be awarded with trophies and silk banners, as well as each athlete with a medal. For 4th to 6th teams will be awarded with trophies.

4) Macao University Students Invitational Dragon Boat Race – Men and Women

The first three teams of the Final will be awarded with trophies and silk banners, as well as a medal for each athlete

5) Macao International Dragon Boat Race (Invitational)–Men’s Open and Women’s Open

5a) The first three teams of the Grand Final of the Men’s Open will be awarded with prize money, trophies and silk banners, as well as a medal for each athlete; for 4th to 6th teams will be awarded with trophies;

5b) Plates will be awarded to the first three teams of the ‘B’ final of the Men’s Open;

5c) Plaques will be awarded to the first three teams of the ‘C’ final of the Men’s

- 5d) Silk banners will be awarded to the first three teams of the 'D' final of the Men's Open;
- 5e) The first three teams of the Grand Final of the Women's Open will be awarded with prize money, trophies and silk banners, as well as each athlete with a medal; for 4th to 6th teams will be awarded with trophies;
- 5f) Silk banners will be awarded to the first three teams of the 'B' final of the Women's Open.
- 6) "Best Time" Trophy
- 7) "Fair Play" Trophy
- 8) "Best Drummer" Trophy
- 9) "Outstanding Costume" Prize
20. **Souvenirs:** Souvenirs will be distributed to all participating teams.
21. **Subsidy:**
1. The Organiser will distribute a subsidy of MOP\$10,000 (ten thousand patacas) to each local participating dragon boat team (MOP\$3,000 /three thousand patacas to each small dragon boat team). If any team fails to participate in its respective races and practice less than three times, the Organiser reserved the right to withdraw the subsidy.
 2. Should any entity participate in the same gender in both the Small Dragon Boat Race and Dragon Boat Race or Small Dragon Boat Race and University Students Invitational Dragon Boat Race, the Organiser will only distribute the highest subsidy (MOP\$10,000).
 3. Subsidy will be distributed in two phases, half before the race and remaining after the race.
22. **Team Sponsor:** Should teams wish to source sponsors, must apply upon registration.
23. **Security:** The Organising Committee will do its best in order to insure the maximum protection to all athletes, yet it will not be responsible for any accidents that might take place during training and the actual races.
24. **Information for participating teams:** All complementary information supplied by the Organising Committee on the races will be considered, for all effects, as integral parts of the respective official regulation of the race.
25. **Appeal:** The Organising Committee will only accept appeals as long as these are communicated through a properly written form (to be collected at the jury), within the period of ten (10) minutes, after the classifications have been announced, along with an appeal fee of MOP\$500 or US\$60, this sum will be refunded to the team should the appeal be granted.
26. **Rules and Regulations:**
- (1) **Macao Civil Servants Small Dragon Boat Race**
- a. If more than 7 teams were registered in this race, teams will be organised into 2

groups and the first 3 teams of each group will qualify into the Final.

- b. If only 6 teams were registered, the Final will be held directly.
- c. The arrangement of lane and group of 1st Heat will be determined by draw.
- d. During the final, the arrangement of lane will be set according to their rankings. Team in the same category with the best time (1st) will be arranged to lane 3, and 2nd to lane 4, 3rd to lane 2, 4th to lane 5, 5th to lane 1, and 6th to lane 6.

(2) Macao Small Dragon Boat Race (Men's Open)

- a. During the Heat, 24 teams will be divided into 4 different groups, the first four teams in last year's final will be considered as seeds and arranged by draw to each group, and the other teams shall be decided by draw to each group as well.
- b. The first three teams in the 1st Heat will be eligible to enter into Semi-final.
- c. In order to even each group's competitiveness in the Semi-final, a "Snake System" will be implemented to distribute the 12 qualifying teams into two different groups accordingly to their results. They will be randomly selected into different groups. Group 1 will consist of 1, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 12. Group 2 will consist of 2, 3, 6, 7, 10 and 11.
- d. During the Semi-final, the first three teams will enter to the Final.
- e. Each team requires to draw for its lane and group in the Heat.
- f. During the Semi-final and Final, the arrangement of lanes will be as per above point 26-1-d.

(3) Macao Dragon Boat Race (Men's Open)

- a. During the Heat, 36 teams will be divided into 6 different groups, the first six teams in last year's Final will be considered as seeds and arranged by draw to each group, and the other teams shall be decided by draw to each group as well.
- b. The first three teams in the Heat will be eligible to enter into the Semi-final.
- c. In order to even each group's competitiveness in the Semi-final, a "Snake System" will be implemented to distribute the 18 qualifying teams into three different groups accordingly to their result. They will be randomly selected into different groups. Group 1 will consist of 1, 6, 7, 12, 13, and 18. Group 2 will consist of 2, 5, 8, 11, 14, and 17, and Group 3 will consist of 3, 4, 9, 10, 15, and 16.
- d. During the Semi-final, the first two teams will enter to the Final.
- e. Each team requires to draw for its lane and group in the Heat.
- f. During the Semi-final and Final, the arrangement of lanes will be as per above point 26-1-d.
- g. Moreover, teams with the best time in the Heat of the Macao Dragon Boat Race (Men's Open) will be qualified to participate in the Macao International Dragon Boat Race (Men) held on 11 June, and the total number of teams qualified in this race will be announced after the international teams are finalized.

(4) Macao Dragon Boat Race (Women's Open) and Macao Small Dragon Boat Race (Women's Open)

- a. If six or more teams were registered in the Women's Open, teams will be divided into two groups in the Heat and the first three teams of each group will enter into the Final. The lane and group of the Heat will be determined by draw. During the Final, the arrangement of lanes will be as per above point 26-1-d.
- b. If six or fewer teams were registered in the race, then the Final will be held directly. The arrangement of lanes and groups will be determined by draw.

- c. Teams with the best time in the Heat will be eligible to participate in the Macao International Dragon Boat Race to be held on 11 June, and total number of teams qualified in this race will be announced after the international teams are finalized.
- (5) Macao University Student Invitational Dragon Boat Race (Men)**
- If six or more teams were registered, teams will be divided into two groups and the first three teams of each group will qualify to the Final. The arrangement of lanes will be as per above point 26-1-d.
 - If six or fewer teams were registered, then the Final will be held directly. The arrangement of lanes will be determined by draw.
 - The winner in the Final will be eligible to participate in the Macao International Dragon Boat Race (Invitational) – Men held on 11 June.
- (6) Macao University Student Invitational Dragon Boat Race (Women)**
- The Final will be held directly.
 - The arrangement of lanes will be determined by draw.
 - The winner in the Final will be eligible to participate in the Macao International Dragon Boat Race (Invitational) – Women held on 11 June.
- (7) Macao International Dragon Boat Race (Invitational) – Men**
- During the Heat, 36 teams will be divided into 6 different groups, the best teams in the Final of the Macao Dragon Boat Race (Men's Open) and the invited teams will be divided into different groups. Moreover, the rest of the teams shall be decided by draw.
 - The first three teams in the Heat will be eligible to enter into the Semi-final. The other teams will enter into the Repechages.
 - In order to even each group's competitiveness in the Semi-final, a “**Snake System**” will be implemented to distribute the 18 qualifying teams into 3 different groups accordingly to their result. They will be randomly selected into different groups. Group 1 will consist of 1, 6, 7, 12, 13 and 18. Group 2 will consist of 2, 5, 8, 11, 14 and 17, and Group 3 will consist of 3, 4, 9, 10, 15 and 16.
 - The arrangement of the Repechages will be the same as the Semi-final.
 - During the Repechages, the first two teams of each group will enter to the ‘D’ Final.
 - During the Semi-final, the first two teams of each group will enter to the Grand Final.
 - During the Semi-final, the 3rd and 4th teams of each group will enter to the ‘B’ Final.
 - During the Semi-final, the 5th and 6th teams of each group will enter to the ‘C’ Final.
 - Each team requires to draw for its lane and group in the Heat.
 - During the Repechages, Semi-final and Final, the arrangement of lanes will be as per above point 26-1-d.
- (8) Macao International Dragon Boat Race (Invitational) – Women**
- If more than 6 teams were register, teams will be divided into two groups and the first three teams of each group will qualify to enter to the Final. The others will enter to the ‘B’ Final. The arrangement of lanes will be as per above point 26-1-d.
 - If six or fewer teams were registered, then the Final will be held directly. The arrangement of lanes will be determined by draw.

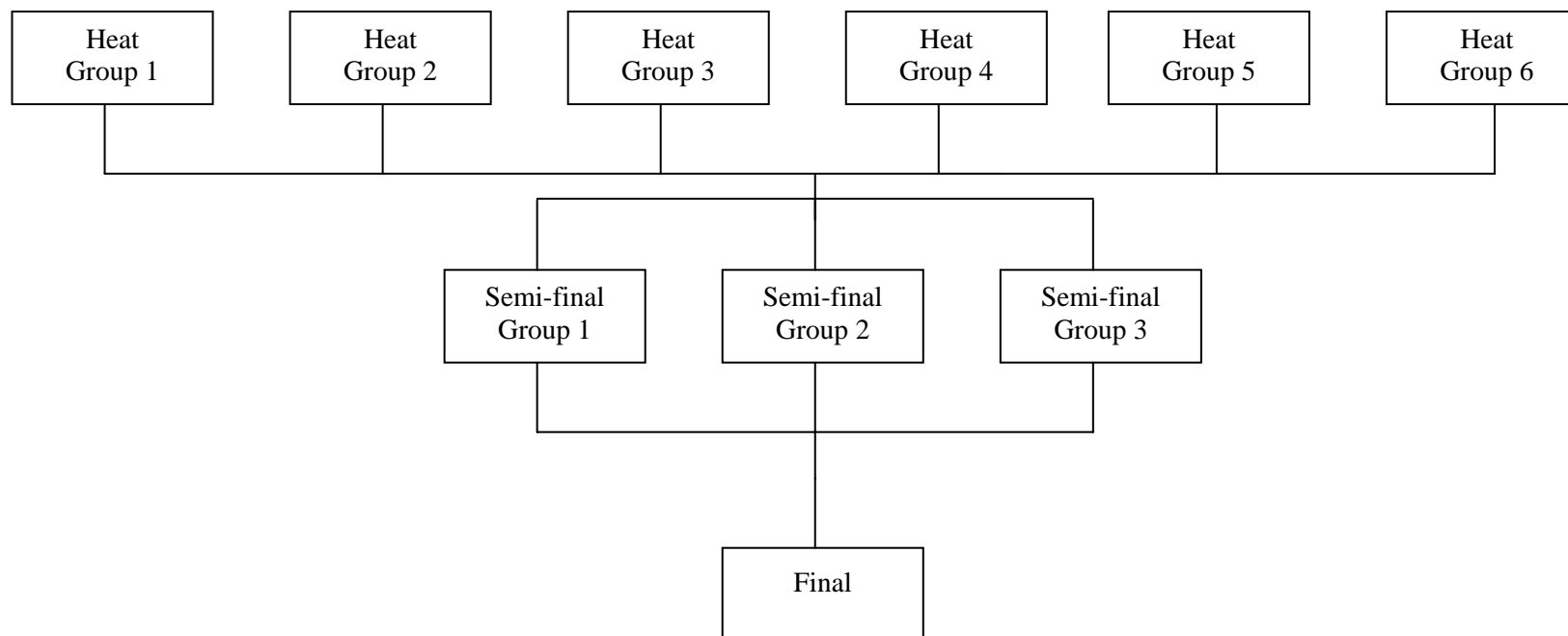
Note: All the omitted cases will be settled by the Organiser, and in case of doubt, the Organising Committee reserves the right of making the final decision on the issue in question.

Macao Dragon Boat Race - Men's Open

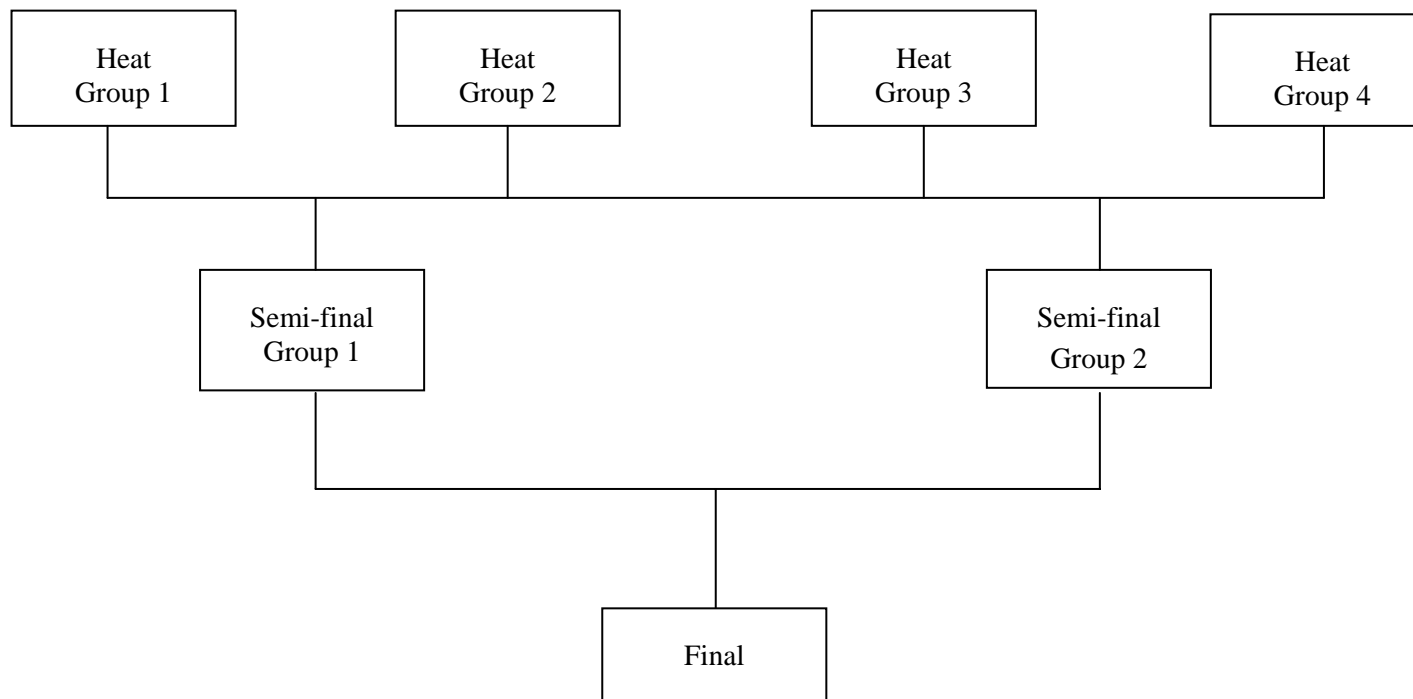

Macao Small Dragon Boat Race – Men's Open

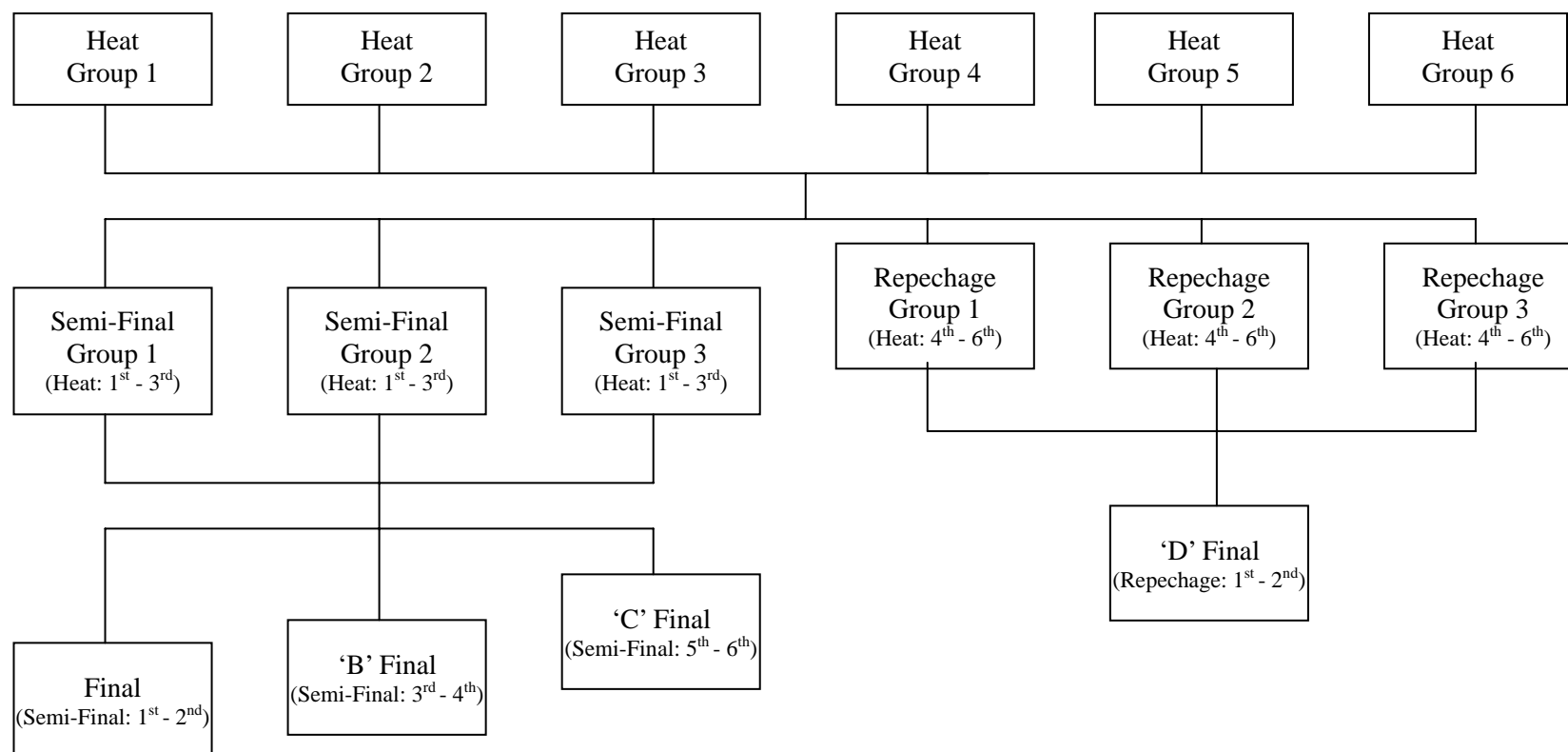

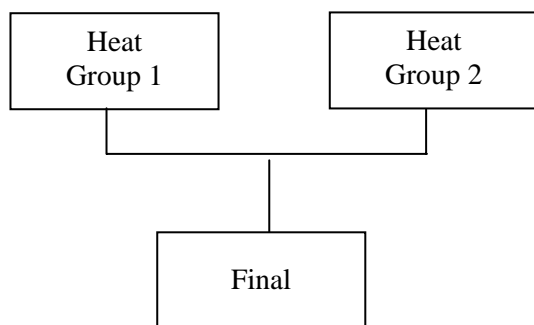
